Bud-break occurred very early in the 2017 vintage, and the flowering process that followed was excellent. June weather was very hot, and then milder temperatures over the summer led to a slow, even ripening of the grapes which brought about a very fine balance in the components of the grapes. The wine displays a beautifully attractive brilliant colour with violet-coloured glints. The nose reveals fresh fruit aromas that are enhanced by blackcurrant and raspberry notes coming through. After a flavoursome entry on the palate, the wine is built around a delicate structure underpinned by lovely freshness.

Harvest: 12 - 26 September

Blending: 100% Merlot
